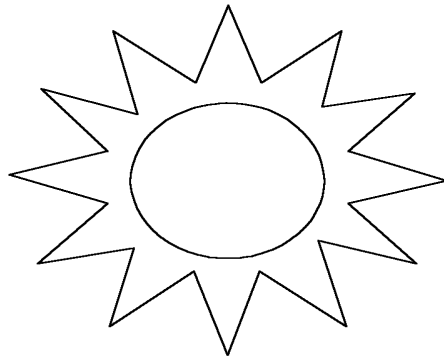

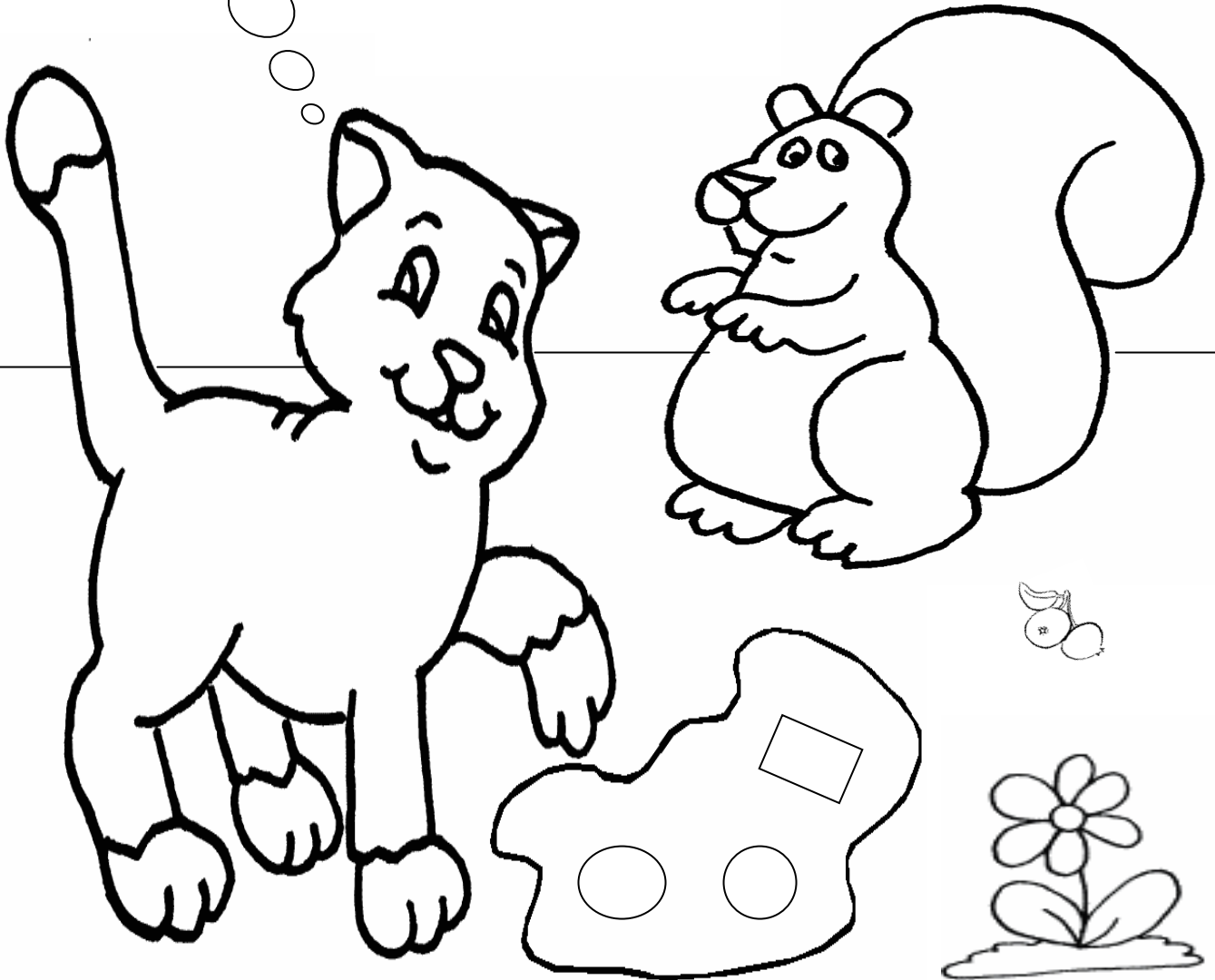

Those treats look yummy!

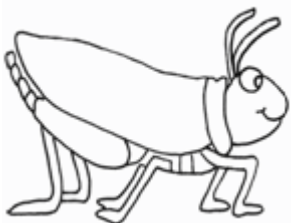
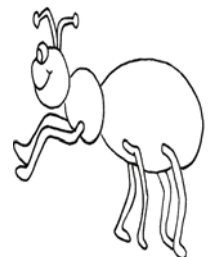
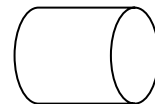
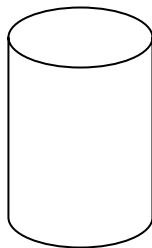
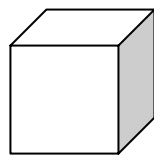
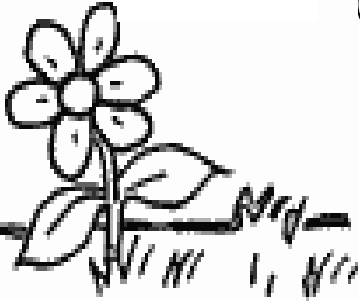
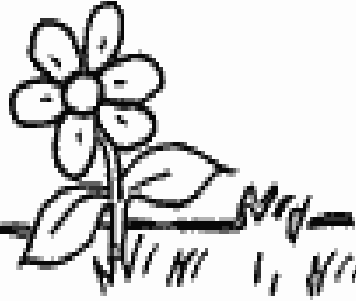

Samuel Squirrel, saddened by the news that he would not be able to scamper through the woods as he once was able to, contacted Leah Lion, a Lawyer.

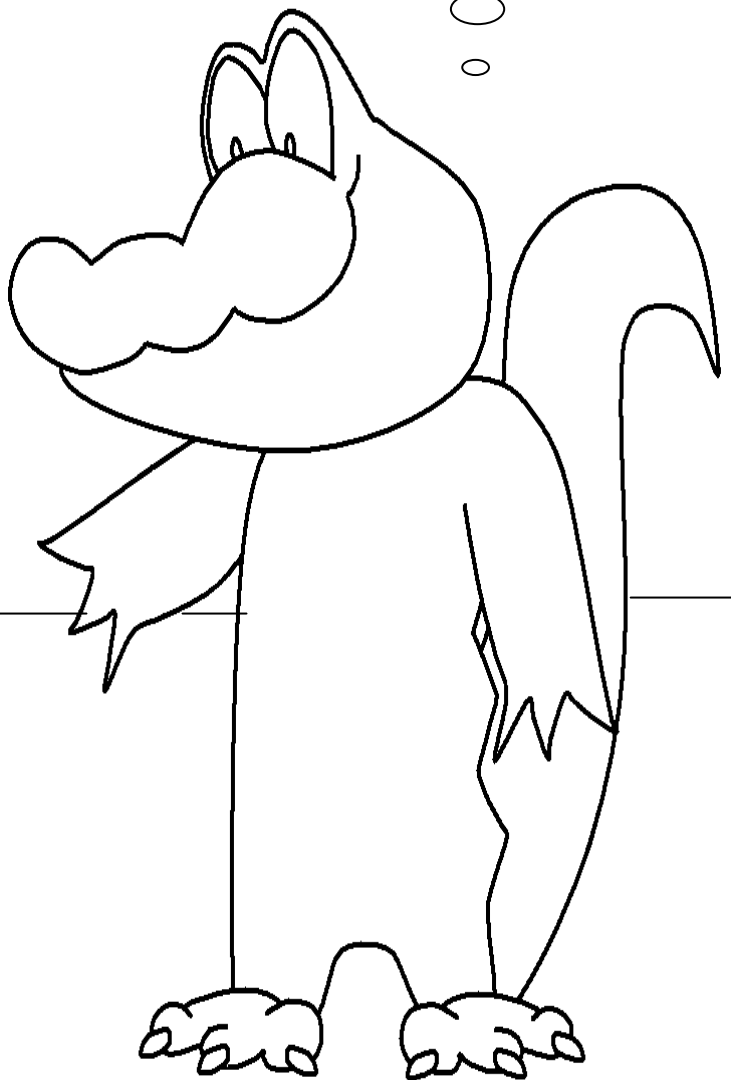
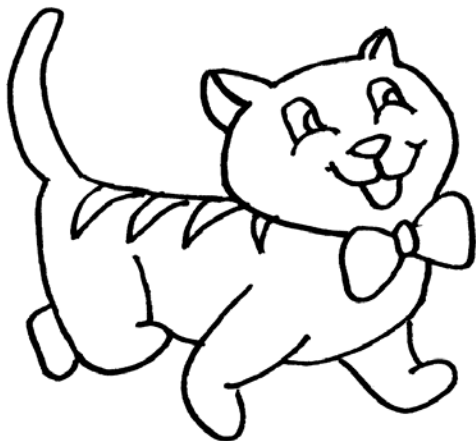
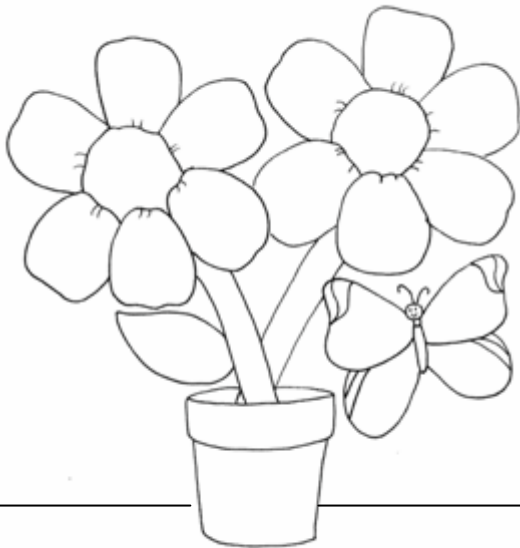
Leah Lion filed a lawsuit against Christine Cat for his injuries. She claimed that Christine Cat was negligent*, and that she should have taken care of her property better.
